BIOFIT Industry Forum

11th September 2019, Leipzig, Germany

Besides erecting entirely new biofuel plants, retrofitting – i.e. replacing a part of a factory or installation with state-of-the-art equipment – can be a very good alternative to substitute fossil fuels or to upgrade renewable technology. Retrofitting often means lower capital expenditure (CAPEX), shorter lead times, faster implementation, less production time losses and lower risks. The BIOFIT project was set-up to foster retrofitting measures on the European market.

What are crucial challenges for plant operators and engineers?

What are the decisive framework conditions for conducting retrofitting measures?

What are the benefits from already implemented retrofits?

These questions are discussed in interactive sessions. There is the opportunity to exchange knowledge, give feedback and hear from experts about best practice examples and experiences with retrofitting.
